<u>Literacy</u>


The children will be writing the labels for a double decker bus. The children will be working on the diagraph 'oo'. We will be using these sounds to spell out simple words.

Personal, Social and Emotion

This week we are going to talk about what makes a good friend. The children will help create a list of attributes that make a good friend.

Understanding of the World

<u>Mathematics</u>

We will talk about and explore 2D and 3D shapes using informal and mathematical language: 'sides', 'corners'; 'straight', 'flat', 'round'. They will be developing their mental math skill by using their fingers to quickly show quantities on 1 hand and recognise the numerals 1–5 They will begin to develop their conceptual subitising skills with linear and paired arrangements of up to 5 dots.
