# Communication and Language

We are working on the children expressing their ideas and feelings about their experiences using full sentences, including use of past, present and future tenses and making use of conjunctions, with modelling and support from their teacher. We would appreciate it if you could encourage your child to speak in sentences and not answer with one word

## Physical Development

On Tuesday we will be having a PE coach in to work with the children. Mrs Pile will continue to work on their games and coordination skills on Thursday morning. Our fine motor control activities will be cutting out. The children will continue to work on writing their letters the correct size and using a good three point grip on their pencils.

#### Personal, Social and Emotion

We will be starting a new topic-Keeping safe, feeling safe. The children will recognise their own contribution to keeping safe and use simple rules for dealing with people and situations. This week we will be looking at how the children can recognise dangers around them and what they can do to keep themselves safe.

### <u>Literacy</u>

This week we will be writing instructions on how to rescue the frozen peas from their icy jail. The children will be exploring the language of our new book and using them in their writing. # Understanding of the World

## Mathematics
