

Communication and Language

This week the children are taking on roles from the story and acting them out. Hopefully, they will include some of the Superhero vocabulary that we have collected. The children will be listening to the story and talk about events and predict what might have happened to the vegetables if Super Tato hadn't come along and rescued them.

Physical Development

On Tuesday morning I will be taking the children for PE and we are going to be practicing for our class Sports Day. Mrs Pile will continue to work on their games and coordination skills on Thursday morning. Our fine motor control activities will be using the scissors.

Literacy

The children will be working on using their capital letters in the correct place and using a full stop. In phonics the children will be consolidating all the sounds learnt so far sound. We will hear all the children read on Friday so please make sure you send their reading books in. This week I will be assessing your child's high frequency words.

Understanding of the World
