

Communication and Language

This week we are working on sequencing a story and remembering details of key events. The children will be collecting new words to do with manufactured and natural material. The children will be making their own Safari Park in the Small world area and explaining what they have created to the rest of the class.

Physical Development

On Tuesday we will be having our games session in the MUGA outside working on balls skills. Mrs Teece will continue to work on skipping skills and Miss Dyson on cycling skills throughout the week. Mrs Pile will continue to work on their games and coordination skills on Thursday morning. Our fine motor control activities will be using locks and keys.

Personal, Social and Emotion

We will be looking at the different factors that support their overall health and wellbeing: - regular physical activity - healthy eating - toothbrushing - sensible amounts of 'screen time' - having a good sleep routine - being a safe pedestrian. This week we are looking at why it is important to drink lots of water.

Literacy

This week we will continue to work on Silly Doggy by Adam Stower. We will be talking about how we can help the Safari guide make wanted posters to help find the missing animals. In phonics the children will be learning about the 'air' sound. We will hear all the children read on Friday so please make sure you send their reading books in.

Understanding of the World
