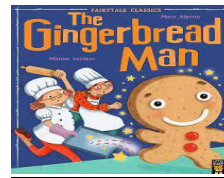
Personal, Social and Emotion

Understanding of the World

Hatchmere will discuss and explore where they live. Do they live close to a park? Who do they live next to? What places in Winsford do they like to visit?

Expressive Arts and Design

The children will be painting their 'favourite thing' this week. They will be thinking about what colours they may need and then creating their own colour palette. Their creations will be displayed within the classroom.

Mathematics

Hatchmere will be exploring the numbers up to and including 3. They will practice recognising 1,2,3 in different forms; subitising, numicon, using fingers to show and seeing if they can spot these numbers within their learning space. They will also look at ordering these numbers from smallest to largest and vice versa.

Parental Involvement Activity

Talk to your child about their family. It can sometimes be confusing to children who everyone is in relation to themselves. Why is Grandad your Dad? Why is Auntie Laura your sister? Also talk to your child about where they live, what is close by (shop/field/park) and where in Winsford they visit often.
