### Communication and Language

The children will be working on their segmenting and blending skills. They will be listening very carefully to CVC words to discover the sounds that make up the word. This task involves working on and possibly correcting pronunciation.

## Physical Development

Hatchmere are really enjoying their P.E. sessions. They are learning how important it is to wake up our bodies to be ready for physical activity. The children will continue to learn new games whilst working on their spatial awareness and gross motor skills.

#### Personal, Social and Emotion

Hatchmere will be exploring friendship. We will look at relationships in the classroom and how we should treat others. We will also look at behaviour that does not follow our school behaviour expectations of Ready, Respectful, Safe.

## **Literacy**

Hatchmere will re-tell the story of the GBM in their own words. They will draw a story map and use the sounds that they know to represent the story. In phonics Hatchmere will be looking learning the sounds o, c, k and ck.

# Understanding of the World

Hatchmere will be exploring their local area this week. We will be talking about our town of Winsford and what it consists of. As we head into Autumn we will be discussing how our town may look different.

# Expressive Arts and Design

The children will continue with their still life drawings of some seasonal flowers. This task requires the children to look closely at detail and colour choice and replicate that on their page. This task supports fine motor skills and cognitive development.

### <u>Mathematics</u>

This week, the children will build on their subitising skills. They will continue to use 'perceptual' subitising - instant recognition - by saying the number of sounds that they can hear, such as claps or drum beats, without needing to count. They will be encouraged to look closely at small quantities and observe whether the quantity has changed or only the arrangement.

## Parental Involvement Activity

Discuss Winsford with your child. Could you visit an area of interest? (Marina, Common, local church, Knights Grange Playing Fields, town park etc). Talk about what makes Winsford a town.
