

### Communication and Language

The children will be using words of encouragement in P.E to support their classmates' efforts. We will be supporting the children to explore the best language to use when doing this. This Hatchmere will work in small groups to design a structure, they will be supported to listen and respond to ideas and then come to a group consensus.

### Physical Development

In the children's P.E session Miss Dyson will be supporting the children to catch and throw a tennis ball consistently. In Athletics on Friday Mrs Teece will be working on the children's sportsmanship as they support their classmates to play team games.

### Personal, Social and Emotion

This week Hatchmere will be exploring our British Values and focusing on The Rule of Law. We will be discussing rules that we have in our daily life and why they are important (keep us and others safe/support us to be happy and confident in different environments)

### Literacy

Hatchmere will be showing off their re-call skills and writing skills with a re-telling of Silly Doggy. Drawing Club will be watching Trapdoor Phonics and making a gruesome breakfast for 'The Master Upstairs'. In Phonics the children will continue to focus on reading and spelling previously taught sounds. The children's reading will be practising their consonant blends with ccvc words (clasp, twist, spend).
