

Number bonds to 10.

In maths we have been learning about number bonds, two numbers when added together that make another number, e.g. $5 + 1 = 6$, or $4 + 2 = 6$. This week's homework focus is on number bonds to 10.

$$0 + 10 = 10$$

$$3 + 7 = 10$$

$$1 + 9 = 10$$

$$4 + 6 = 10$$

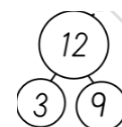
$$2 + 8 = 10$$

$$5 + 5 = 10$$

To help the children to develop their recall of these important maths facts, we would like them to use the following websites at home this week.

This video will probably drive you mad, but music is a great way to learn, and the video also has some great visual models that the children will be familiar with, e.g. the part whole model.

This is a really simple game where children can practice their rapid recall of the number bonds to ten.

Select 'Number bonds' and then the 'make 10' icon. How many points can you score in one minute? This is a really good game to come back to and encourage the children to beat their previous scores.

The aim of this game is to free the whale by adding the piece of pipe that completes the number bond to 10, e.g. If there was an 8 piece pipe you would need to add a 2 piece pipe to make 10, tap the water wheel and free the whale!
