The Green Cross Code?

STOP, LOOK, LISTEN, THINK

STOP - Find a safe place to cross.

Try to find somewhere there are no parked cars
and if there is a safer place to cross use it!

LOOK - Look all around

Don't forget to look behind you,
especially at junctions.

LISTEN - Listen for traffic.

Don't forget you might not hear electric cars,
bicycles or scooters.

THINK - Think 'Is it safe to cross?'

Online safety

Stay Safe - Keep yourself safe by not telling anyone online personal information like your full name, address, phone number or where you go to school. Don't tell friends your passwords. Keep them safe.

Don't Meet Up - Meeting up with someone you only know online can be very dangerous. They may be nice but they could be pretending to be someone else. Always check with an adult you trust.

Accepting Files - Accepting pictures, texts, messages, emails and files from someone you've only met online can cause problems. What they send you may have a computer virus on them that can ruin your computer or phone.

Reliable? - Don't believe everything you see and hear online. Some people may say or write things that aren't true. Check information before you believe it.

Tell someone - If you're unsure or worried about something online ask an adult you trust. If you get nasty messages or anything that makes you feel uncomfortable tell an adult. Never reply to the messages even if they say you have to. Speak to an adult or call Childline 0800 11 11.
