Communication and Language

We will be sequencing the Gingerbread Man story and creating our own story maps to help the children retell the story. The children will be acting out the story and will be encouraged to use the descriptive words from the story.

Physical Development

In gymnastics this week we will be travelling and moving on different body parts. The children will start to use the mats. In games we will be practising our underarm throwing and aiming.

Personal, Social and Emotion

We will be talking about what we contribute to the whole school. We will be asking the question how to do we help our school community. The children will be talking about what they do to help at home.

Literacy

The children will be word building with the letters they have learnt so far. We will be sequencing the Gingerbread story and writing simple labels to go with the stories.



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Understanding of the World

This week we are going on an Autumn walk to Knights Grange to see what signs of Autumn we can see. The children will be talking about why the world around us is changing.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be using the material we found on our Autumn walk to create a collage. The children will be making leaf rubbings and looking at the colours and textures of the material they have found. The children will be working on performing and singing with Mrs Pile.

Mathematics

We will continue to explore numbers to five using action songs, numicon, number blocks and looking at the formation of numbers. The children will be using positional words and exploring their meaning.

Parental Involvement Activity

This week we are going on a walk to Knights Grange to look for signs of Autumn. I would like you to look out for signs of Autumn in your garden and in the environment around you. Talk to your child about the changes that are happening around you and discuss why this is happening. This could include the change in the weather, the darker night, the leaves changing colour and falling, nuts and berries on the plants, birds flying south, plant seed heads and the lack of insect life. See what you and your child can spot.
