

Communication and Language

This week we are looking at the sequence of our day. We will be explaining what we do and asking appropriate questions of each other. We will be using time words such as the days of the week, morning, afternoon, night, next, after that, later and soon.

Physical Development

The children will be working on ball skills on Monday and gymnastics on Tuesday. The children will be practising their letter formation and pencil grip.

This half term we will be looking at Emotional Health and Well-being. This week we will be talking about how we can express our emotions. The children will be listening to a variety of music and will be encouraged to express how it makes them feel.

The children will be writing letters to the character's mum talking about what the naughty bus has done. The children will be working learning the names of the letters in the alphabet. This week the children will be reading to me and we are working on blending sounds to hear the word.

Understanding of the World
