


# Woollen Bunny Card

## Supplies


- Coloured card
- Cotton wool
- Pencil
- Glue Stick
- Pom-pom
- A rabbit coloured shade of wool



- Googly eyes
- Felt pens



**1** Fold a sheet of A4 card to make a greetings card.



**2** Draw two circles, one on top of the other to form a body and head for a bunny. Also draw two ears at the top of the smaller circle.



**3** Cut lengths of wool long enough to fill inside the circle shapes.



**4** Begin to glue the wool inside the bunny shape you have drawn. This could be in any pattern you choose, ensuring the whole area is covered.



**5** Stick cotton wool to fill the inside of the bunny's ears, then leave to dry.



**6** Use a felt pen to draw on top of the pencil outline to make it stand out.



**7** Stick googly eyes to the face and pom-poms for the tail.



**8** Once dry, write a message inside the card.

# Woollen Bunny Card




## Supplies
