


Craft Instructions


Felt Easter Basket

Supplies

- Basket template
- Pieces of felt (cut into the template shape)
- Wool or string
- Foam shapes
- Scraps of felt
- Blunt darning needle
- Scissors
- Sequins
- Hole punch
- Strong glue



1 Take the large pre-cut piece of felt and using the dotted lines in the template as a guide, cut four lines into the fabric.




2 Using the template as a guide, use the hole punch to make six holes in the correct places on the felt. Also, use the the hole punch to make one hole at either end of the handle.



3 Thread a blunt darning needle with wool or string, then thread through three holes on one end of the basket and gather them together.



4 Tie a knot in the wool or string and trim the excess off.



5 Repeat the same as step two but on the other end of the basket.



6 Now attach the handle by re-threading the wool on the needle and threading through the holes in the handle, and then through the felt of the basket. Once the thread has gone in and out of both holes, secure the string or wool by tying a knot and trimming the ends.



7 Decorate the outside of the box using stickers, fabric sequins and scraps of felt. Attach these using the strong glue.


Felt Easter Basket



Supplies

- Basket template
- Pieces of felt (cut out into the template shape)

- Strong glue





Step 1. Take the large pre-cut piece of felt and using the dotted lines on the template as a guide, cut four lines into the fabric.



Step 2. Using the template as a guide, use the hole punch to make six holes in the correct places on the felt. Also, use the hole punch to make one hole at either end of the handle.



Step 3. Thread a blunt darning needle with wool or string, then thread through the three holes on one end of the basket and gather them together.



Step 4. Tie a knot in the wool or string and trim the excess off.



Step 5. Repeat the same as step two but on the other end of the basket.

**Step 6.**

Now attach the handle by re-threading the wool on the needle and threading through the holes in the handle, and then through the felt of the basket. Once the thread has gone in and out of both holes, secure the string or wool by tying a knot and trimming the ends.



Step 7. Decorate the outside of the box using stickers, fabric sequins and scraps of felt. Attach these using the strong glue.
