# Felt Bunny Bag

### Supplies

- two shades of square shaped coloured felt (we used 20x20cm)
- blunt needle
- thread
- pencil
- black felt tip
- strong glue



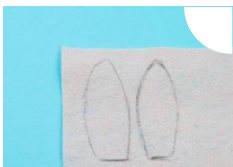
- googly eyes
- pom-poms for tails
- coloured ribbon
- scissors



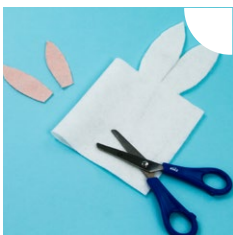
Fold the felt in half.



Using a pencil, draw bunny ears onto the felt. Make sure the ears are touching each other!



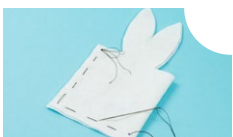
Draw two ear pieces and a nose onto the contrasting piece of felt. Make sure these fit inside the bunny's ears.



Use scissors to cut around the ears on the body. Also cut out the ovals and triangles from the contrasting felt.



Thread the needle and make a large knot at the end. Starting with the open side, sew in a running stitch down the side and across the bottom.



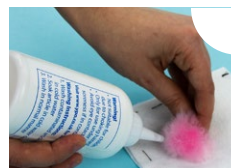
Secure the ends of the thread with a knot at the back, then trim the ends.



Using strong glue, stick the ear pieces, googly eyes and nose onto the bunny.



Draw a mouth using a black felt tip pen



To make a tail, use strong glue to stick a pom-pom onto the back of the bag.



Fill the bag with treats or a special Easter note.



Finally, use a length of a ribbon to tie the bag together at the top, just below the ears.

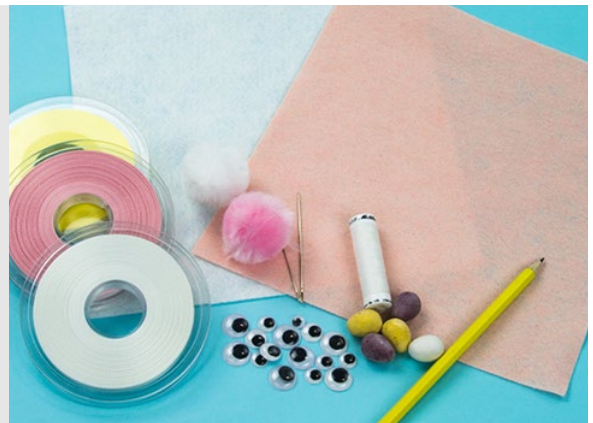

# Felt Bunny Bag



## Supplies

- two shades of square shaped coloured felt (we used 20x20cm)

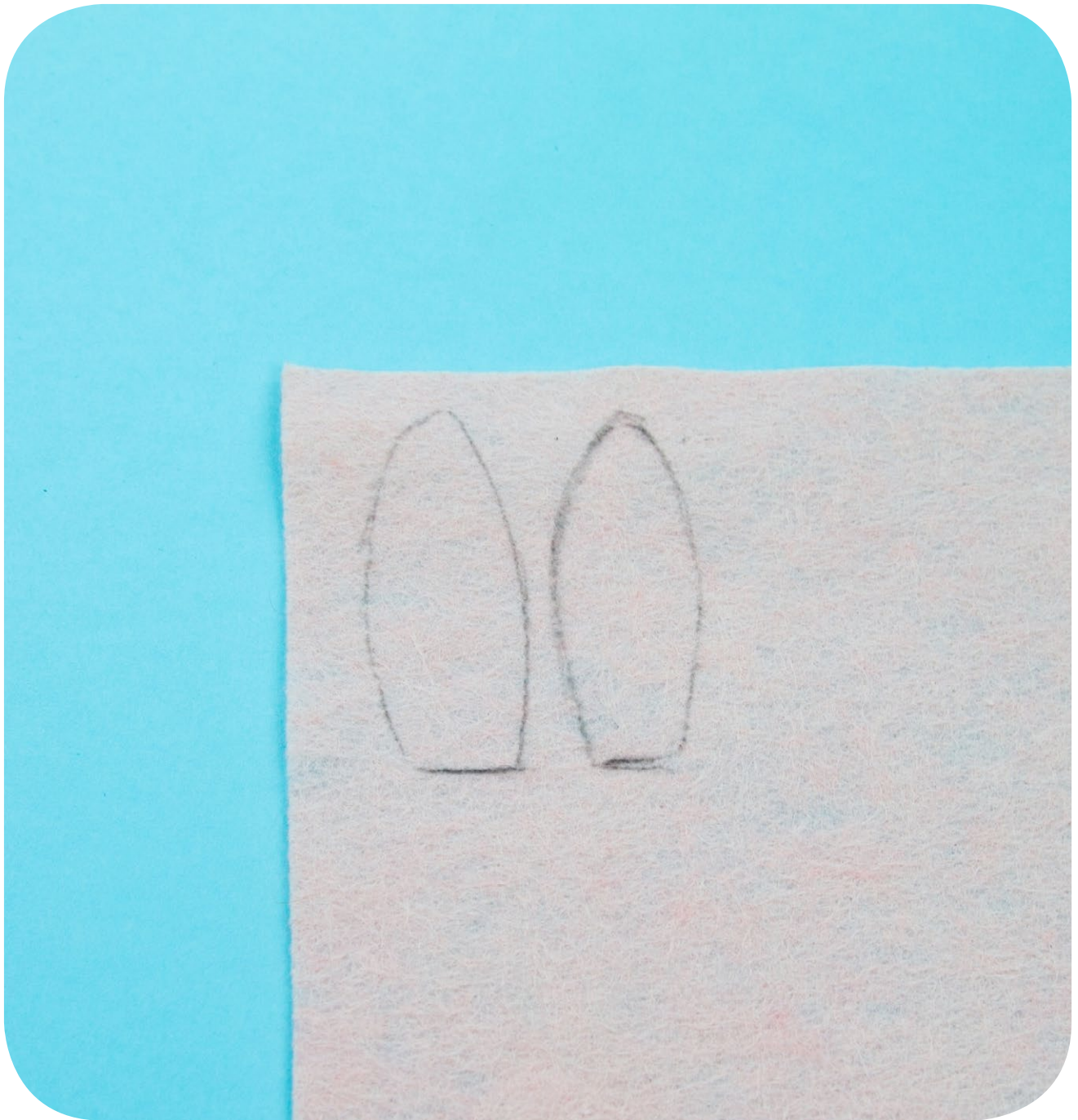
**Step 1.** Fold the felt in half.



## Step 2.

Using a pencil, draw bunny ears onto the felt. Make sure the ears are touching each other!





### Step 3.

Draw two ear pieces and a nose onto the contrasting piece of felt. Make sure these fit inside the bunny's ears.



## Step 4.

Use scissors to cut around the ears on the body. Also cut out the ovals and triangles from the contrasting felt.





## Step 5.

Thread the needle and make a large knot at the end. Starting with the open side, sew in a running stitch down the side and across the bottom.





## Step 6.

Secure the ends of the thread with a knot at the back, then trim the ends.



## Step 7.

Using strong glue, stick the ear pieces, googly eyes and nose onto the bunny.





## Step 8.

Draw a mouth using a black felt tip pen



## Step 9.

To make a tail, use strong glue to stick a pom-pom onto the back of the bag.





**Step 10.** Fill the bag with treats or a special Easter note.



## Step 11.

Finally, use a length of a ribbon to tie the bag together at the top, just below the ears.
