

Communication and Language

This week we are going to introduce the story 'The Gingerbread Man' to the children. We will be acting out the story and setting up a bakery in our classroom.

Physical Development

The children will be doing games on Thursday morning with Miss Pile. In the Outside Classroom we will be teaching the children several chase games and working on their special awareness.

Personal, Social and Emotion

This week we will talking about rules and why we have them. We will talk about how rules keep us safe and makes sure everyone is treated kindly. The children will be introduced to the Golden Rules used throughout the whole school.

Literacy

We will be reading our story and talking about the actions of the characters. The children will be encouraged to predict events and make links with their own experiences. We will be learning the letter p, i and n and start to use these to build words. The children will be working on letter formation and recognition.

Understanding of the World

Mathematics

We have been learning several different counting rhymes that help us learn the number names and order of numbers to five. The children will be working on recognising and forming the numeral three. We will share the story of Goldilocks and the three bears and use this story to help us recognise the value of three
