



Remote Learning at Over St John's CE Primary School

This information is to be used as a general guide and parents can expect further details of remote learning for their child as and when it is required.

We aim to implement remote learning within your child's first day of absence. There are 2 general scenarios outlined below: the first scenario where your child is not permitted to attend school and the second outlines the actions in the case of a whole bubble not being permitted to attend school.

Circumstance	Remote Learning
My child (<i>and their siblings if they are also attending Over St John's CE Primary</i>) is absent because they are awaiting test results and our household is required to self-isolate. The rest of their school bubble are attending school and being taught as normal.	<p>If your child is ill, work will not be provided until they are feeling better, as would usually be the case.</p> <p>If your child is well but having to isolate due to other members of the household presenting with symptoms or as a result of a positive test, then we will aim to send work home from your child's second day of absence.</p> <p>Work will be sent via School Spider to your registered email address. This email will contain further information for you and your child about the attached work.</p> <p>The work sent home will be, as far as possible, exactly the same as that which is being delivered in school.</p> <p>If you need to communicate with your child's class teacher about their work, then please do so through their class email address (see below). This email is only to be used in relation to your child's work and must be sent from an adult's email address. This may be questions about what has been set or to share work that your child has completed. My child's whole bubble is not permitted to attend school because they, or another member of their bubble, have tested positive for Covid-19. We enter another 'lockdown' with total school closure.	<p>Class teachers will send work daily, via School Spider, to your registered email address. This will follow the same curriculum as would have been delivered if the class were still in school/school was open. The email will contain further details of the work and how to complete it.</p> <p>You will be able to make contact with your child's class teacher through the class email address, as listed above. This email will be monitored between 8:45am and 3pm every week day until a return to school is possible. All emails sent must come from an adult's email address due to safeguarding regulations.</p> <p>Class teachers will stay in contact with you via the School Spider email system. Completed work, photographs etc can be sent to the class teacher via the class email address and the teacher will provide feedback to your child via the School Spider email system, where needed.</p>
