

Communication and Language

This week we are going to be collecting baking and Harvest words and exploring some of the descriptive words in our Gingerbread book. The children will be recounting part of the story.

Physical Development

Understanding of the World

Expressive Arts and Design

Mathematics

We have been learning several different counting rhymes that help us learn the number names and order of numbers to five. The children will be working on recognising the numerals to five and working on forming them correctly. The children will be sorting objects using a mathematical criteria.

This week I will be sending home a simple word building task to help the children start to word build. This is an activity that should be done little and often. Children of this age will struggle to concentrate for longer the five to ten minutes. Make it a positive activity with lots of rewards and the children should enjoy doing it.
