Communication and Language

The children will be using talk to organise the story and what they did during the Christmas holidays. They will be talking about how to make a snowperson and what resources they need to make one. We will be collecting winter words.

Physical Development

The children will be working on their games skills with Miss Pile and ball skills with me. We will be talking about the different ways we stay healthy including the importance of sleep.

Personal, Social and Emotion

We will be talking about how people earn money and what jobs they do to earn the money. What does working for a living mean. How can we help? What do we do-what is our job?

Literacy

They will be working on recognising the sounds ch, sh and th. They will be using these sounds to build simple CVC words. The children will be writing sentences about winter and labelling a snowman.



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Understanding of the World

We will be looking at different parts of the world that get a lot of snow and how the live in those conditions. If we have a frosty morning or snow, we will be going out to have a look at the changes we see. We will be talking about the signs of winter.

Expressive Arts and Design

They will be working on creating a collage picture of a snowperson, painting a picture of a snowperson and using playdough to create a 3d snowperson. We will be looking at how to create darker and lighter pictures by adding black and white to a colour.

<u>Mathematics</u>

The children will be looking at number bonds to five. We will be investigating how we can make five and working out which numbers fit together. The children will be completing a range of games and activities to cement this knowledge.

The children will be revisiting repeating pattens and how to make them.

Parental Involvement Ideas

This week we would like you to look for signs of Winter. This may include frost in the morning, colder temperature, short days, no leaves on the trees, no insects around, not as many birds and of course snow! Talk to the children about what clothes do we need to wear in winter? Talk to the children about your memories of snow and what you did in the past when it snowed.
